

# Sister Hazel - Just Remember

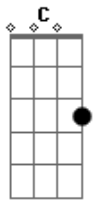

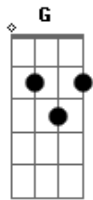
**G**

(Chorus-Chorus)

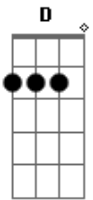
