Intro: low harmony part

E **F**

bend up & down

up & down

high harmony part

bend up & down

acoustic intro riff:

E

F **C** **B**

power chords w/ are the rythm guitar that comes in behind the acoustic riff after the first four times or so.

E 022--- **F** 133--- **C** 3355-- **B** 2244--

a second rythm guitar comes in later playing the same chords in different positions.

E -799-- **F** -81010-- **C** 3355-- **B** 2244--

the **E** and **F** are strummed in 16th notes.

main thrash riff:

E **Eb**

verse riff:

E **Eb** **E** **F?** **E** **Eb**

1/ **E** **C Eb** 2/ **E** **Ab G**

CHORUS:

E **G** **Gb**

close your eyes, look deep in your soul, step outside your mind

and let yourself go **G Gb**

E **F** **Ab** **G Gb**

as you go insane, go insane

1ST SOLO RYTHYM: variation on Verse Riff played 1 step (2 frets) higher; no 1st and 2nd ending w/ power chords - instead continue riff for a 4th measure.

2ND SOLO RYTHYM: Chorus chords.

SOLOS: comments by Matthew Holliman

King's solo is based on **Ab** locrian if I remember right.

Hanneman's begin with an arpeggiated Am7, played up an octave each time, beginning with **A** (6 stg) 5 fr. The tapping bit is 12-8-5-8-5 13-8-5-8-5, on the 2nd string, then again on the 1st string. The final bit is 10-5-7-8 on the 1st string, then up to the 22nd fret, a half-step at a time.
