D And she said, "I suppose you've heard... about Alice?"

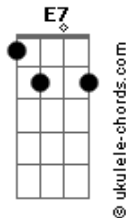
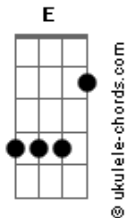
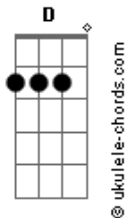
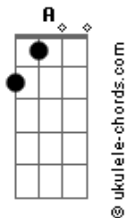
