

Sonic Youth - Teenage Riot

Tom: G	for the main riff of the song, lee backs up T with this harm.
Thurston's tuning: GABD <mark>EG</mark> Lee's tuning: GGDD <mark>GG</mark>	(t)=pick rapidly with much speed
Thurston's parts Intro:	it's really tough to hear what lee is playing for the verses. most of the time, he's just playing open strings and some harmonics. here's a little thing that sounds cool. harm
and when the song kicks in, T plays this	
Verse riff:	lee's chorus riff
Chorus chords:	don't be afraid to throw in some of those high g strings in with the chorus riff
	for the break, lee starts off with : G 0
the break starts with a rapid strumming of this chord	then, go back to the main riff
	in the last verse, lee throws in some little riffs
after that bit, go back to playing the main riff and back to the verse and chorus parts end on big <mark>G</mark> chord (same chord used for beginning of break)	at the first run thru of the verse riff, lee plays this:
Lee's part	then, at the end of the verse, right before the last chorus,
all of lee's parts are really low in the mix, so i'm not completely certain if this is	lee plays
correct. but, it's close enough. this is one song where it doesn't matter if it's played sloppy. in fact, it sounds better that way.	and that's all
