'Cause I remember it all, all, all

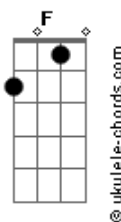
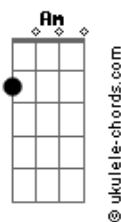
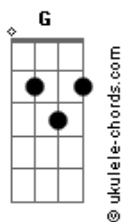
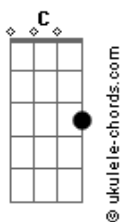
