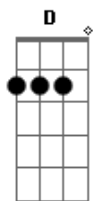

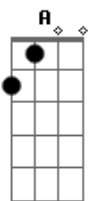

 Oh, my, my, my

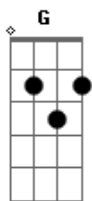

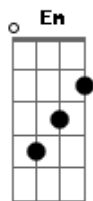
