They'd seen his face before

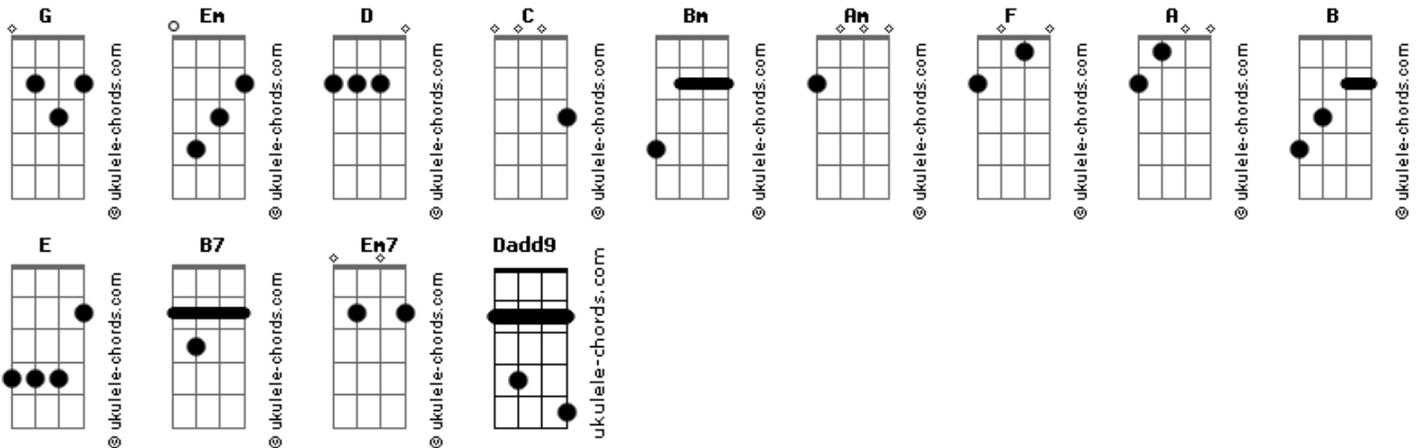
Em Em C
