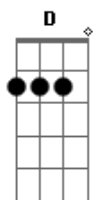
.. and here's the fun part. Cool the way the chords "turn around"

While the verses are going on, the rhythm guitar repeats the intro parts over and over with slight rhythmic variations. The lead guitar does dozens of variations along the following lines:

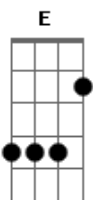
