

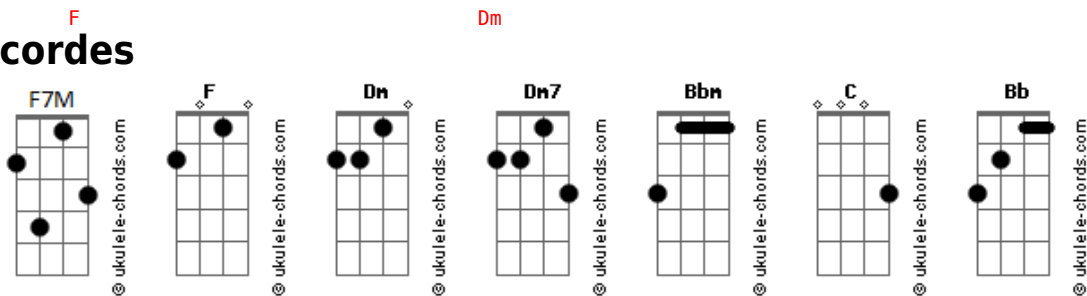
The Brudi Brothers - Me More Cowboy Than You
