^C And sometimes I like living in my own world ^{Am}

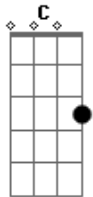

^C But the truth is I

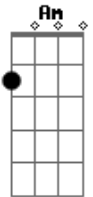

^{Em} And I would rather live and die in fantasy ^G

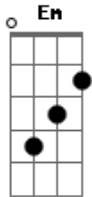

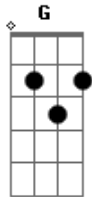
